

**ABBY KELLEY FOSTER CHARTER PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING AMERICAN HISTORY GRANT GRADUATE CREDITS FOR \$333 *PER COURSE***

Abby Kelley Foster Charter Public School's Teaching American History Grant is pleased to announce that, in partnership with Worcester State College, we will be offering graduate credits for \$333 *per course*. Two three credit courses per year will be offered over the remainder of the grant (through the fall of 2010) for a total of 5 courses.

Dr. Charlotte Haller, Assistant Professor of History and Coordinator of the M.Ed. programs at Worcester State College, will coordinate the courses based on the historical content being covered by the grant. Dr. Haller will provide academic oversight, assign projects—e.g. final unit plans with both content and classroom applications, and will grade assignments. Dr. Haller will collaborate with Dr. Thomas Doughton, the lead scholar, in order to ensure consistency and to satisfy the goals of the grant.

Those taking the courses may apply them toward M.Ed. History requirements at Worcester State College, transfer credits toward other programs, or use them toward step pay increases in their school districts.

***There are no additional fees attached to these costs.*** Most content texts and reading materials are provided free of charge through the grant.
